Welcome

Staff/Key person

We would like to welcome Saba who will be joining the pre-school room. All children have an allocated key person. Please ensure you know who your child's key person is.

Being late

Can we please remind parents picking up their children that they arrive on time. May we remind parents that our 'Parents Pack', given to you upon registration, states that there is a £5 charge for every five minutes of lateness picking up children. We really do not like charging parents for this but have put the charge in place in order to deter parents from doing this on a regular basis.

Packed lunch

As all children are bringing in packed lunches, we would like to remind parents about our healthy eating policy. Healthy food is a large part of the nursery ethos. When children eat a healthy diet from a young age, they learn life-long healthy eating habits. Therefore can we request parents do not include crisps and chocolates in their child's packed lunch. We also have children with nut allergies, can we ask you not to include any nuts in your child's packed lunch.

Labelling clothes

Can we please ask all parents to label their child's coats, lunch bag, clothes and the like so that we can ensure that everyone gets back their child's belongings. You can do this with a permanent marker by initialling your child's name on the tag in clothes or in the corner of a lunch box. If clothes are not labelled, the nursery cannot take responsibility for lost items. We thank you for your cooperation in this respect.

EyLog

From September, all observations and child learning information will be completed via the EyLog. Please can all parents ensure they have activated their account(s). If you have still not received an email with a pin and user e-mail, please speak to your key person. Just as you would have received the learning journey book at the end of every half term, you will receive information about your child learning development. We ask you to bear with us for this term whilst the staff transition from paper to on-line. If there are any problems in accessing EyLog, please do not hesitate to contact us.
