If your child is claiming a funded place or is not paying full day fees, we would like to remind you of the 50p per day charge for snack. Payments should be made on weekly basis to staff.

Increased Fee

Due to national changes in legislation our running costs have increased dramatically, whilst we will shoulder some of these costs we will also have to unfortunately increase our fees from September 2018. The price increase will be as follows;
