It is important we instil reading for pleasure in our children as research has shown, this is the single biggest indicator of a child's future success, more so than the child's family circumstances, the



parents educational background or the household income. Surveys suggest reading for pleasure is at its lowest since 2005 with fewer than 1 in 2 (47.8%) children saying that they enjoyed reading either very much (18.4%) or quite a lot (29.4%). To help promote this, we will give every child a book token which they can exchange for a book at local bookstores. To instil a love of reading and to make it exciting for our children we

wanted to encourage the children to dress up as a character from a story in the Quran/or their favourite book on **World Book Day on Thursday 2nd March 2023**. If you would like ideas or support in how to be creative and make your own costume, please speak to a staff member for ideas.
