
Asalam Alaikum / Peace be upon you all,



World Book Day

A study published in 2019 that involved taking MRI images of children's brains showed that taking away screens and reading to young children can boost brain development. The MRI images indicated an increase in organised white matter that is involved in developing language and ability

Increased fee

Due to national changes in legislation, our running costs have increased. Whilst we will shoulder some of these costs, we will also have to unfortunately increase our fees from January 2022 by £2:

Toddler room from £36.50 to £38.50

Pre-school from £35.50 to £37.50

Please note there will be a further increase in September of £2.
