Communication Champion

Welcome to our first communication champion section in our newsletter. Recently we have appointed one of our practitioners as our 'communication champion'. Here you will find information and guidance to support your child with their communication and language development in the early years.

You can find some quick and easy ways to help you child here...

Toddlers

You can help your child by...

- Sharing stories together
- Singing songs when you're getting your chid dressed or changing their nappy
- · Holding your toddler's hands to help them make the actions as you sing songs
- Talking about the sounds you can hear all around
- · Playing games where your child must follow instructions like "roll the ball" or "throw the ball"

Two year olds

You can help your child by...

- Using sock puppets, toy people or animals when you're sharing stories or songs
- · When you are making a sandwich together, talk about what you are doing
- · Joining your child in their play, talking about what you are doing and what things are called

Three and four year olds

You can help your child by...

- Playing listening games like "Simon Says...." or "Ready, Steady, Go"
- Making up silly sentences where each word begins with the same sound at the start of your child's name
- Talking about things you have done together and what you might do later
- When you're tidying up give your child simple instructions like "Put your shoes in the basket"
